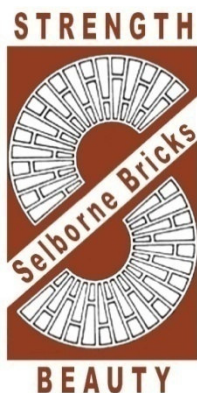


Selborne Hand Finished Imperial, Bespoke and 2 Inch Facing Bricks



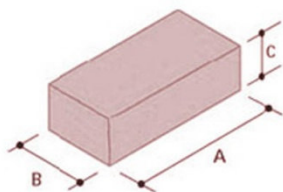
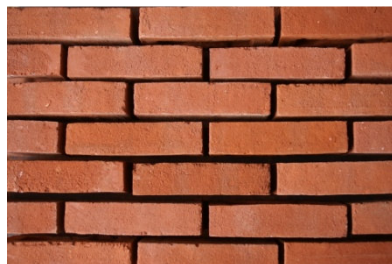
Brick making predates the metric system, and many extensions and renovations have to match bricks that were made to a different size. With our labour intensive process and highly experienced craftsmen we can usually help.

The size determines the cost – some dimensions require significantly more effort than others, and are priced accordingly.

We can also manufacture specials [plinths, cants, bull nose, copings and capping] to match imperial [or any other] dimensions. They are available in any of our current range

2 Inch bricks have a lowered height, which changes both their proportions and therefore the whole look of a wall. A 2 Inch wall looks completely different to the more common sizes, typically making the wall look longer and lower.

The sample panel on the right shows the effect.



The key information that we need to know is the dimensions of the brick. “Imperial” sizes tend to be a recipe for confusion as there are several standards. In older houses the bricks were probably made from clay excavated at the site. Please ensure that we have dimensions A,B and C from the diagram

Technical Data

The performance of our metric facing bricks was tested to BS EN 772 in February 2008 by CERAM. The results are summarised below and the full test report is available on request or can be downloaded from our website.

Water Absorption: 8%

Initial Rate of Water Absorption: 1.4 Kg/(m².min)

Soluble Salts:S2

Frost Resistance: F2 [Severe Frost]
